

# Minutes

Town of Forest

September 13, 2016

The September Board Meeting was called to order at 6:08 PM by Chairman, Alex Puig. In attendance were: Alex Puig, Danny White, Henry Stanek, Jeanetta Kirkpatrick & Patience Duhnke. Jeff Burrer and Jimmy Carley joined the meeting later.

Alex Puig affirmed that the meeting notice was properly posted on the website and at the official sites last Thursday.

Minutes from the July and August meetings were read. Alex moved to approve the July minutes, seconded by Danny; the July minutes were approved. There are several changes to be made to the August minutes. (1) Under Public Comment and the Hanzel/Keys dispute, Deb Hanzel will take the case to court. (2) Under New Business (1) The entire paragraph referring to the recycling sign should be removed since that was in the July minutes. (3) The camera was already purchased. (4) Estimates for the recycling area will be coming soon, not tomorrow. Alex moved to approve the August meeting with the four corrections, seconded by Danny; the motion passed.

Patience Duhnke presented the Treasurer's report.

Henry Stanek gave the Patrolman's report. He and Fred have been working to repair the storm-damaged roads. Mullendore, Ash Ridge, Goose Creek, Benson Hollow (new tube) all need more filling and grading.

Kia Workowski was to appear to discuss the damage to his croquet court along the town road. The Town will not repair the croquet court, but Henry will remove the berm.

Danny requested more detailed information on agenda items.

## Old Business

Received a bid from an Amish gentleman for a 24' x 60' x 14' pole building that includes: 16" overhangs, no concrete, (3) garage doors, (1) man door, 4x3 windows, total bid \$17,000. Alex would like more estimates before a decision is made on the trash area building.

## New Business

Alex moved to raise Fred's hourly wage by \$1/hour starting with the next pay period, seconded by Danny; motion passed.

Set the Fall Clean-Up for October 22, 2016.

Jeff Burrer volunteered to man the recycling/dumpster building on Saturdays. Alex offered \$10-\$12/hour compensation.

Discussed the severe damage to Benson Hollow Drive. Jim Chitwood has been very helpful with cost sharing by County thru State of Wisconsin. Should cover 75% of road repair and 50% of improvement (new tube). Work to be done later this week.

The monthly bills were approved with addition of \$12,000 loan payment for the grader. Motion to approve by Alex, seconded by Jimmy.

The next meeting was set for October 18, 2016. Motion to adjourn by Alex, seconded by Danny. The meeting adjourned at 7:05 PM.
